## Day One (17<sup>th</sup> March 2011)

The delegation consisting 35 Progressive farmers started from Himmat Nagar to Anand by bus. Delegation arrived at **Anand Agriculture University** in the evening.



## Day two (18<sup>th</sup> March 2011)

They visited **Sardar Smriti Kendra SSK** and Dr. S.M.Patel (In charge of SSK) took a lecture on general agriculture and AAU activities in farmers well fare, agriculture and rural development in Gujrat state, he also tolled in brief about Organic agriculture. Farmers learnt about the organic pesticides, microbial activities in soil and proper management of soil fertility.

Dr. R. J. Jadhav (Horticulture Department) AAU, has delivered a lecture on scientific farming of Bar, Amla and pruning methods in deferent horticultural crops. He also tolled about the cultivation practices of Sapota, Citrus Fruits, Papaya, cultivation.

## Day three (19<sup>th</sup> March 2011)

Dr. K.M. Patel from horticulture department has delivered a lecture on papaya cultivation and papen production. He also delivered a brief lecture on nursery management, virus free seedlings production.

He also tolled about the horticulture farm management, irrigation system in horticulture farms, Insect pest management, Bardo mixture, management of alternate bearing in mango crop.



## Day four (20<sup>th</sup> March 2011)

Smt. Jayshree Patel (Floriculture Department) has delivered a lecture on modern cultivation practices of different flower and cut flowers in Gujarat state.

She also briefed about post harvest management of flowers (Sorting, Grading, Packaging), farmers also learnt about different marketing channel in Gujrat and in India for exporting the produce.



## Day five (21<sup>st</sup> March 2011)

Dr. P.M. Bhatt (**Head ATIC AAU**) has delivered a lecture on biofertilizers and their recommendation in different crops. He also tolled about the balance use of chemical fertilizers, pesticides, insecticides, fungicides. He also delivered a lecture seed treatment, seed dormancy, biofertilizers application while seed treatment, different biofertilizers (Azatobactor, Rhizobium, PSB Bacteria, Azolla).



## Day six (22<sup>nd</sup> March 2011)

Dr. S.M. Patel has delivered a lecture on **BT Cotton cultivation technology**. Farmers also saw the video of animal husbandry, horticulture practices in deferent crops, success story of Gujrat women farmers in milk production.
