

Objectives of the Tour

CARD shall organize the visit of State Government officials and progressive farmers to Hannover, Germany and can also arrange meetings with officials, experts and agribusiness executives to facilitate technology exchange programs, projects, business and trade cooperation between National institutions, companies with the State. The arrangements will also be explored for providing training and cooperation in transfer of technologies in Agricultural Mechanization. The Visit also includes various sites of agriculture advancements, including High-Tech Farms, Institutions and Farm mechanization companies.

In its 2018 edition, **EuroTier** aims to confirm its position as the leading event for the Animal Husbandry sector. The record numbers of the 2016 edition confirmed the growth trend that for years has characterized the Hannover exhibition.

Cattle Breeding in Germany

From an economic view, cattle are seen as the most important livestock of German agriculture. About half of all farmers in Germany breed cattle to produce milk, meat or both. Germany is the largest milk producer in the European Union (EU) and after France the second largest producer of beef and veal. Germany has around 12.9 million head of cattle in total, which includes 4.2 million dairy cows and 0.7 million suckler cows. Germany's cattle production (milk and beef) has a vast production value and contributes about 25 percent to the agricultural output.

Germany is the world's largest exporter of breeding cattle and one of the leading countries in the export of bovine semen. More than 40 breeds are bred, 80% of which consist of the major breeds: German Holstein black and white and red and white, the German Fleckvieh (Simmental), and the German Braunvieh (Brown Swiss). The remaining 20% are divided into eight local rare breeds and about 30 beef breeds. Cattle production in Germany has a long tradition, is well-organized, and brings a lot of experience to the table in the breeding sector. This includes insemination on farms, milk production and slaughtering. The basis for sustainable breeding programmes and effective management of the farms are the high standards of the performance and the quality testing of milk and dairy cattle.

Around 2.6 million cattle are registered in herd books and 3.5 million cows are registered for milk recording.
