Agriculture is the principal source of livelihood for more than 58% of India's population and contributes 15% to the country's GDP. Though the Green Revolution in the 1960s has made India selfsufficient, but there are still numerous challenges viz., land fragmentation, marginal and subsistence nature of the Indian farming, soil degradation, water scarcity, indiscriminate use of chemical fertilizers and pesticides, etc. More than 83% of farmers have landholdings of less than two acres. Limited post-harvest infrastructure, untimely weather events and weak value chain linkages have resulted in post-harvest losses as high as 30% for fruit and vegetables. Food and nutritional security is now a major concern more so in the wake of climate change and is thus, a national priority. In this purview, CARD has been playing an unassuming role in the field of environment, agriculture and rural development, since its inception in the year 2000. CARD acts as a bridge between the network of Agricultural Community and various other stake- holders of this sector (State and Central Governments, International Organizations, Bilateral Developmental agencies, Corporate, Academia, and End-users) through large-scale projects on the field. I am appreciative of all who have extended their unswerving support to build CARD into an institution of great repute and grow its unfailing passion to work for advancement of the rural communities. CARD resonates with the sentiments of Father of India's Green Revolution, Dr. M.S. Swaminathan:

If Agriculture tails, everything else will tail "

Thus, we have to work relentlessly to help build capacities of our farmers, agri-preneurs, agro-based industries, etc. and make agro-technologies available to farmers in all parts of the country in order to have higher productivity and continued self-reliance

Current Agriculture Scenario in India

Agriculture in India is undergoing rapid market and technological transformation. It has moved from the situation of 'ship to mouth' to food surplus, from subsistence farming to sustainable agriculture, from man driven to technology driven, from production to market oriented and from food importer to net food exporter. Thus, agriculture has come a long way, contributing significantly to food security, employment generation and foreign exchange earnings. But, the issue of global warming and climate change is posing a new threat to the sustainability of our environment and agriculture and livelihood of masses.

Centre for Agriculture and Rural Development (CARD) is dedicated to give voice to the cause of the communities and to strive towards improving the quality of life of masses through protection of environment and promoting safe and sustainable farming systems. CARD undertakes training, capacity building and technology exposure by organizing business and technical seminars, workshops and technology fairs, livelihood projects and entrepreneurship development programs. CARD monitors trends in agriculture and further advises Central and State Governments and various bodies on appropriate policies and actions for the development of agriculture, and the rural economy.

Rural Livelihood Projects:

CARD has been actively engaged in working towards improving the livelihoods of our rural communities. It has worked on various integrated community-based interventions across India that aimed to improve rural incomes through modern farming practices, water management, soil conservation, livestock and animal husbandry, market linkages, crafts, etc. CARD has worked on holistic development of different segments of rural community including farmers, women, children, youth, etc. However, it has still greater role to play in the wake of climate change which is leading to extreme weather events, decreased farm productivity and income, shift in production calendars, vulnerable food-, nutrition- and livelihood security. CARD intends to work closely with government, financial institutions, corporates, Banks and Knowledge Institutions to mitigate the negative effect of climate change on our sustainability.

Entrepreneurship Development:

- CARD since 2008 is helping agriculture- graduates develop their entrepreneurial skills, by carrying out their capacity building and skill development in different agriculture and allied sectors. CARD has been recognized as Nodal Training Institute (NTI) by MANAGE Hyderabad and has three centres in Uttar Pradesh. So far, over 1000 candidates have undergone training in these centres. CARD not only provides training but also facilitates their link-up with the financial institutions for getting loans and subsidies for their venture. To scale up this initiative, CARD intends to set up additional NTIs with the support of MANAGE in others states viz., Bihar, Uttarakhand, Odisha, MP, Jharkhand, etc.
- > Under Uttar Pradesh Agriculture Development Project, CARD had established more than 150+ Bhagidari Agribusiness Centres in various districts of Uttar Pradesh at block level. A unique system of monitoring and evaluation has been evolved to build their capacity and to support them to be sustainable business.
- Agripreneur Support: In the past CARD has facilitated number of agripreneurs set up their agriculture/ allied-sector related ventures. CARD not only provides handholding in terms of getting loans and subsidies from financial institutions, but also helps in setting up and operationalization of the same

Awareness and Capacity Building:

- > Indian agriculture today faces an unprecedented challenge under the emerging global environment of trade and agriculture in post WTO era. The training and advice to the farmers has to be on a continuous basis. CARD regularly organises training programs for farmers on the productivity improvement, marketing, exports, crops diversification, organic farming and value addition etc. Besides farmers, CARD has organized several training and capacity building workshops for rural youths on self-employment opportunities.
- > CARD has also organized number of national and international exposure visits for farmers, to give them a real-time experience of various technologies and innovative and successful cropping methods followed in different regions by their fellow farmers. It helps them replicate such innovative technologies and methods in their fields and improve their farm productivity and income. CARD is the only national level organization conducting farmers' tour on behalf of various state governments, district authorities, banks, institutes and agribusiness industry. It has over 50 training and tour modules for Farmers.
- CARD also intends to work in the areas of skills development, knowledge integration, IT enablement, capacity building and performance enhancement of farmers, NGOs and extension functionaries.
 CARD has identified major gaps in, production, marketing, value addition in establishing a farm based production and processing unit by farmers.

Farmer-Industry-Agripreneurs Networking Platforms:

CARD in its endeavour to bridge the gap between various government bodies, financial institutions, corporates, academia, students and farmers, organizes various events annually. These events are a great platform to network and draw synergies between different stakeholders leading to development of effective value chains. CARD organizes exhibitions, conferences and seminars to provide a platform to all. In addition to the seminars and conferences, it organizes two flagship events every year, AgroTech and Vibrant North East, in Lucknow and Guwahati, respectively.

Farmer Engagement:

Since its inception CARD has been working closely with the rural communities, especially farmers. It has been recognized as Resource Institute by SFAC and has been empanelled as Cluster Based Business Organization (CBBO) by NAFED. It has been allocated 15 Farmer Producer Organizations (FPOs) in Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand and Bihar by NAFED and 8 FPOs by SFAC-Haryana. An FPO stands for a group of farmers and producers. A wide range of services, including technical assistance, marketing, processing, as well as other facets of farming, is provided through Farmers Producers Organisations. CARD is continuously making efforts to promote partnerships among the farmers, industries and institutions ensuring stability in the lives of Indian farmers. CARD envisages to set up more FPOs in divergent sectors of agriculture through the implementing agencies under Central Sector Scheme or Private bodies.


